Do you want to start off the next academic year strong?

Get yourself seed funding from the Special Interest Group on Sustainable Behaviour!

(extra) Research money? Yes, this funding opportunity will provide you with a budget to set up a collaboration within the Special Interest Group (SIG) on Sustainable Behaviour. With this seed funding, you can, for example, organize an interactive workshop, recruit participants, or fund any materials needed for your collaboration. These are just examples of what you could use this money for, but you are free to come up with your own ideas. A total of 3 projects will be selected to receive €1.000 funding each.

For which purpose? This funding is all about collaboration and sharing knowledge with peers and colleagues within the domain of sustainable behaviour. Therefore, the research must have a link with this domain.

For whom? Any members of the Sustainable Behaviour SIG mailing list can submit a proposal. The only requirement is that at least 1 of the applicants is part of the Copernicus Institute. If you are not yet on the mailing list, you can sign up [here](#). Note that also master thesis supervisors can submit a proposal to take the research of their student to the next level. This call is open to both junior and senior staff.

Hybrid participation is possible. Feel free to bring any colleagues or fellow students to this session.
